

2008 Owen - Shackelford Grant Awards – Rules and Regulations Sponsored by Teleflora and TSFA

The contest will be held at the TSFA Convention/CTPFA Christmas Show, Franklin Marriott Cool Springs, Franklin, TN, on Friday, August 1, 2008 from 12:00 P.M. until 2:00 P.M.

1. Contest is open to any active member of TSFA or any full-time employee (full-time is 30 working hours a week) of an active member shop.
2. The contestants shall be interviewed individually by the judges. The judges will be appointed by the TSFA Executive Director. Any judge who has vested interest in any contestant must excuse him/herself from judging.
3. The employer or industry sponsor of each contestant shall submit a typewritten letter of recommendation for each contestant. This recommendation along with the contestant application should be mailed directly to the Scholarship Chairman.
4. Each contestant will be required to make two designs: Funeral Arrangement and Table Arrangement.
5. Flowers and materials, including containers and foam for all designs will be furnished. Some or all of each material provided must be used in one or more of the two required designs. Each designer need not use all the flowers assigned, but CANNOT swap or trade quantities with other designers. Each designer will make the designs in order.
6. All contestants are asked to report to the Scholarship Chairman, thirty (30) minutes before the contest is to begin for briefing. Contestants will be given a sealed envelope containing two numbers selected at random. One number for each completed design. A master sheet containing each contestant's name and selected numbers will be retained by the Scholarship Chairman. No other person will have access to this document.
7. To complete the designs all contestants must bring necessary tools: scissors, knife, wire, tape, etc.
8. The time allowed to complete the two designs will be one hour. Designers will work alone and will be allowed no assistance except that furnished by the Scholarship Committee. There will be no talking among the contestants.
9. Judging will be immediately following the contest. The judges will have access to the judges tally sheet only. Judging each design for its individual merit. Completed designs will be grouped to category, ie: all funeral arrangements together, etc. Upon completion, each judge will place all his/her notes in an envelope and give to the Scholarship Chairman.
10. A total point system will be used with a possible 100 points. The interview will be 40 points and the design contest 60 points (Originality 15 points, Physical and Visual Balance 15 points, Mechanics and Workmanship 15 points and Overall Design 15 points). The contestant with the highest number of points will be awarded 1st place. The contestant with the second highest number of points will be awarded 2nd place and the contestant with the third highest number of points will be awarded 3rd place. Employees or family members of the Scholarship Committee members are ineligible to compete.
11. The Scholarship Committee will tabulate the results of the judges scores. They will retain this information until the award presentation.
12. The 1st place winner will receive a grant in the amount of \$750.00, 2nd place will receive a grant in the amount of \$500.00 and 3rd place will receive a grant in the amount of \$250.00. The grant can be used for TSFA Certification, to attend a National Design School and/or workshops and must be used August 2, 2009. The grants can be used to cover tuition, travel expenses, lodging and meals up to the amount awarded subject to the approval of the TSFA Board of Directors. The winners must send a letter of intent of how the grant will be used to the TSFA treasurer by February 1, 2009. The TSFA treasurer will send the tuition or fees directly to the school/association. The expenses incurred will be paid to the winners after completion of the certification, schooling and/or workshop(s). The winners must submit receipts for traveling expenses, lodging and meals to be reimbursed by the TSFA treasurer. The winners must remain employed by an active member shop until completion of the certification, school and/or workshop(s). If for some reason the winner(s) cannot attend their grant will be forfeited. If the winner(s) does not attend without just cause, approved by the TSFA Board of Directors, they will not be eligible to enter a future grant contest sponsored by TSFA.
13. All entries must be postmarked no later than Monday, July 21, 2008.
14. Each contestant will be notified their application has been received.
15. Each contestant must be registered for the convention and will be responsible for their personal TSFA Convention expense.
